Site Requirements

Use this guide to understand the space, access, power, water, drainage, and service needs for a LiftBlend location. Every installation is adapted to the property and applicable local requirements.

Planning item	LiftBlend site guidance
Equipment envelope	Approx. 2.14 m wide × 1.05 m deep × 2.30 m high
Equipment weight	Approx. 400 kg
Front operating space	1.8–2.5 m for customer use, loading, cleaning, and panel access
Rear clearance	0.2–0.5 m from wall for cooling-fan operation
Side clearance	At least 0.8 m on left and right for maintenance
Top clearance	At least 0.5 m for maintenance and disassembly
Floor guidance	Level, stable floor with 450–500 kg load-capacity guidance
Power	110–240 V, 50–60 Hz, 2,000 W maximum; dedicated grounded outlet
Water	Direct potable water with approved filtration or bottled-water configuration
Drainage	Free-flow wastewater and overflow routing; no trapped or submerged discharge
Environment	Indoor or similar indoor; altitude ≤2,000 m; –10°C to 30°C; RH ≤85%

Inside the machine

LiftBlend combines 10 × 12 L fruit storage bins, 4 × 2 L liquid boxes, 4 × 2 L powder channels, two 16 L bottled-water positions, 200-cup capacity, 100-straw capacity, a 12 oz / 340 ml beverage format, automatic cup and lid handling, flexible payment options, remote monitoring, and automatic post-order cleaning actions.
